- Limited visibility or control for schools
- Not designed with diverse literacy needs in mind

Guardrails Matter

For AI to work in schools, it needs:

- Clear admin control over features
- Ability to enable or disable functionality
- Transparency around data use
- Alignment with school and system policies

- Access → helping students read and understand content
- Process → helping students engage with information
